- Use the correct channels for communicating with the school: Class Teacher, Phase Group Leader, Leadership Team, Headteacher and Chair of Governors

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Learning at Home

Learning continues in every part of our lives. 85% of your child's time is spent outside school so it is important to make good use of this opportunity.

In line with parent feedback, this will be in the form of basic skills practice (reading, spelling and arithmetic, including times tables) as well as creative projects and retrieval practice through Knowledge Organisers linked to our Contexts for Learning.

It is critical that children read every day, either through Read, Write Inc texts sent home, myOn (our KS2 online library) or through a book from home or borrowed from school.

Uniform

Uniform reflects a pride in the school and respect of the school rules. If you are eligible for free school meals, we may be able to provide you with items at no cost; please speak to the office or come and visit our pre-loved uniform shop, open every Friday morning (8:40-9:00).

Our uniform consists of:

- White polo shirt (plain or logo)
- Navy blue sweatshirt, cardigan or jumper (plain or logo)
- Grey trousers or skirt
- Grey, black or white plain socks or tights
- Blue checked summer dress
- Safe, sensible black shoes or all black trainers (no other trainers or boots)
- For PE; a white t-shirt (with house colour), blue shorts/tracksuit, trainers or plimsolls and a PE hoodie

Please help to support the school's ethos and uphold the school uniform policy.

Please note that at Lingfield we do not allow jewellery (earrings need to be a simple stud), nail varnish or acrylic/gel nails. Hair styles must be appropriate for school with long hair tied back off the face.
